Project Grants for Visual Artists

2007 Guidelines

VNFA Project Grants provide rapid, small resource to Vietnamese visual artists who wish to complete their work for exhibitions or public projects. Grants of up to \$200 will be awarded to artists who have a specific project and dates to present the work. Artists may be eligible for only one grant per calendar year.

Eligibility:

- Must be a full-time resident of Viet Nam.
- Must be working in the visual arts (e.g., painting, drawing, photography, printmaking, sculpture, installation, experimental film and video, interdisciplinary/mixed media or performance art.)
- Must be a working artist. Art students are also eligible to apply in their final year of studies.

Grants will support:

- Purchase of extra materials needed to complete your exhibition, not core expenses.
- Printing announcements, posters, catalogues, etc. for your exhibition.

Application materials:

- A brief project plan describing the work you are doing and how the AP grant would help to enhance and/or to complete your work (one page).
- A detailed CV outlining education, grants/awards received and exhibition history if any.
- A written confirmation of your participation in the project from the organization that hosts the event. All opportunities will be verified.

- Sample of work: submit 3-5 jpeg images (500K/ea) of work completed in the last three years on a CD-Rom.
- Multimedia/performance artists may also submit ONE CD-ROM or DVD featuring up to 3 segments of work made in the last 3 years, edited to maximum 2 minutes in length for each segment.
- A list of submitted work including title of each image, dimensions, medium and date.
- All documents must be typed in 12-point size font. Hand-written, emailed, faxed applications will NOT be accepted.
- Include a stamped, self-addressed enveloped if wish to have your application materials sent back to you. Viet Nam Foundation for the Arts is not responsible for lost or damaged materials.
